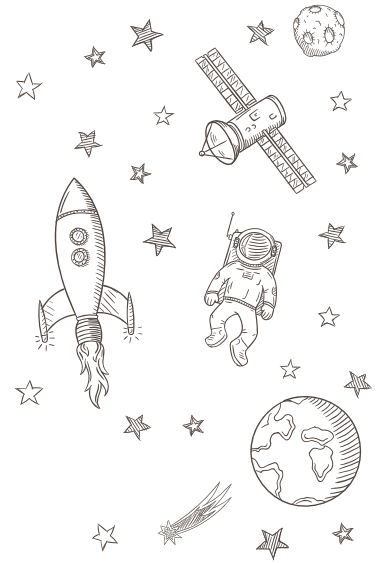

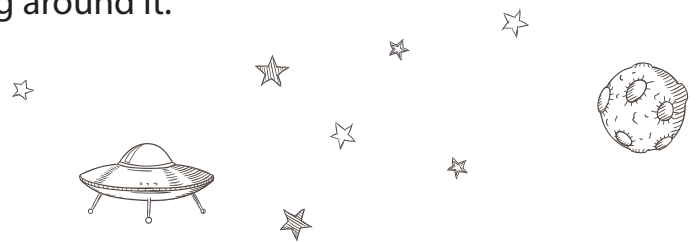
astronaut: A person who travels in a spacecraft into outer space.
