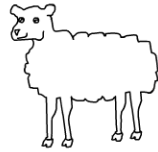

Craft activity

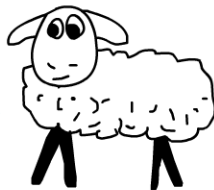
Using materials such as cotton wool, a cardboard tube, paper, bits of wool (yarn), and pipe cleaners, make your own sheep.
