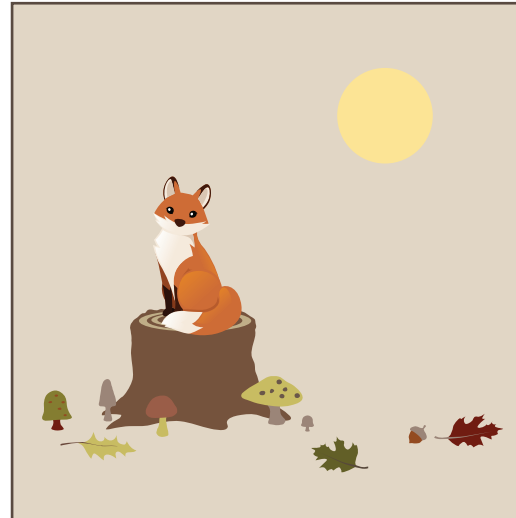


Plurals - adding 'es'

Singular Form:

fox

(a single fox)



Nouns can be written in singular form or in plural form.

Plural Form:

foxes.

(more than one fox)



Plural means more than one.

Plurals - adding 'es'

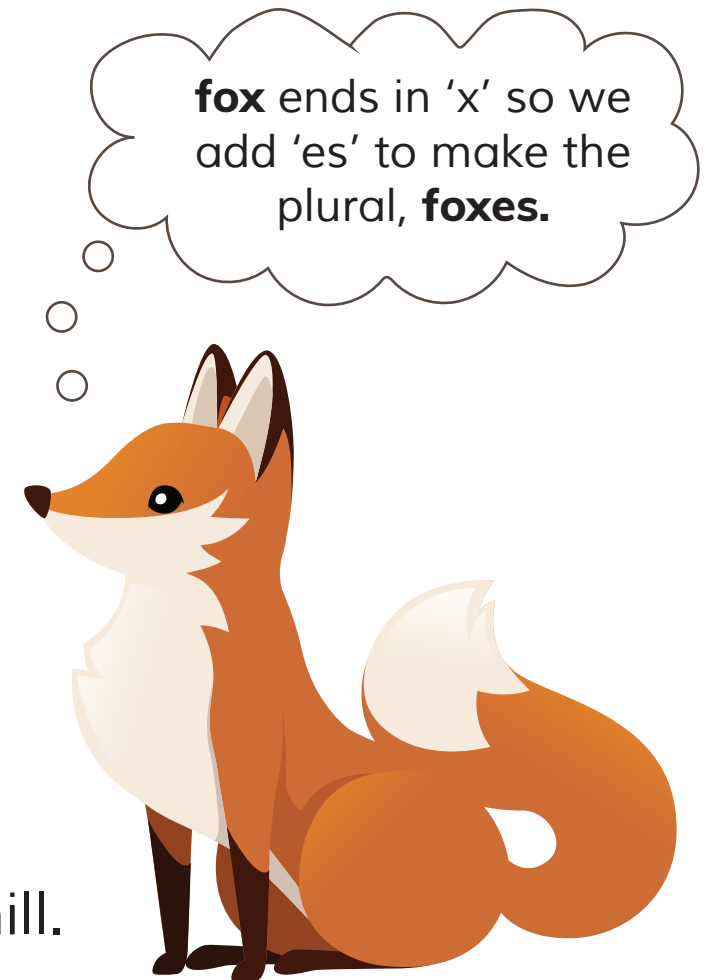
We usually just add 's' to the noun to make a plural. But, sometimes we need to add 'es'. You will often hear 'uz' at the end of these plurals.

The plural of nouns ending in
ch, sh, s, z and x

are formed by adding 'es'
to the end of the word.

Last Monday I saw a **fox** running over the hill.

Last Monday I saw three **foxes** running over the hill.



Plurals - adding 'es'

Sally used a thick **brush** to paint her picture.

Sally used different **brushes** to paint her picture.



Plurals - adding 'es'

What are the plurals of these nouns?

bus

lock

bird

cross

marsh

paper

match

screen

moss

pencil

eraser

box

bear

patch

drink

radish

sport

fish

shark

church

Remember, if the noun ends in **ch, sh, s, ss, z and x**, add 'es' to make the plural.
