



Multiplication facts - 5X

- 1 In the pond there are 8 lily pads. On each lily pad there are 5 frogs. How many frogs in the pond?





- 9 In my class there are 6 reading groups with 5 children in each group. How many children in my class?





- 4 Each box has 5 cans of beans. How many cans of beans in 7 boxes?




