



# Plurals - words ending in "y"



If the base word ends in a "y" preceded by a vowel, just add "s" to make the plural.

example:

**boy**

(has an "o" (vowel) before the final "y")  
add "s" = **boys**



If the base word ends in "y" preceded by a consonant, change the "y" to "i" and add "es" to make the plural.

example:

**puppy**

(has an "p" (consonant) before the final "y")  
change "y" to "i" and add "s" = **puppies**
