

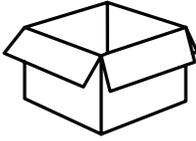


# Plurals add "es" rule

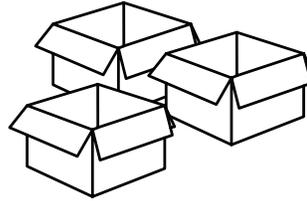


A noun that ends in *ch*, *sh*, *x*, *s* or *ss* needs "es" added to make the plural.  
You can hear an "ez" sound when you say the plural.

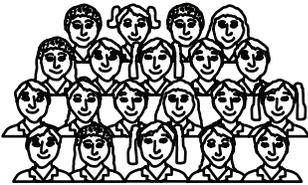
