

# Antonyms using a prefix

An antonym is a word opposite in meaning to another word.

A prefix is a word or letter placed before a word to change its meaning.

By adding the prefix, "un", to happy, it becomes unhappy.



# Word wall: antonyms using a prefix

continue **dis**continue

legal **il**legal

patient **im**patient

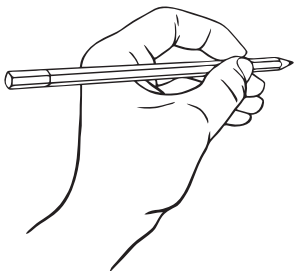
complete **in**complete

regular **ir**regular

available **un**available

likely **un**likely

social **anti**social

# Antonyms using a prefix

Adding the prefix, "anti": clockwise becomes, anticlockwise

Adding the prefix, "in": complete becomes, incomplete

Adding the prefix, "dis": order becomes, disorder

Adding the prefix, "ir": relevant becomes, irrelevant

Adding the prefix, "im": mobile becomes, immobile

Adding the prefix, "il": legal becomes, illegal

Adding the prefix, "un", to available, it becomes unavailable
