Examples:

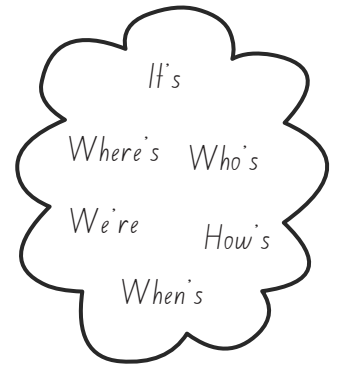
you are = you're (the 'a' in 'are' is missing and is replaced by an apostrophe)
