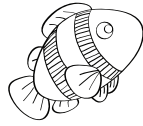

Circle the creatures that are fish.

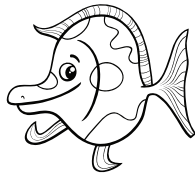

Create a tropical fish collage using scrap pieces of paper and material.

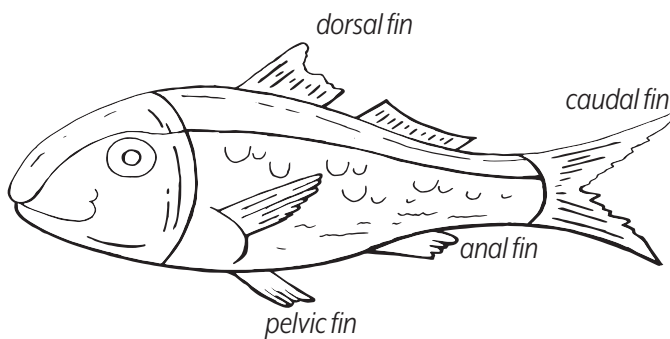


Fish Fins
