Tasmanian tiger facts

The Tasmanian tiger is not a tiger. It is a large carnivorous marsupial that was native to Tasmania.

Most scientists believe it is extinct. However, each year there are some unconfirmed sightings in remote areas of Tasmania.

Tasmanian tigers are believed to open their jaws wider than any other mammal, up to 120°. From the 1820s, farmers hunted Tasmanian tigers because they killed sheep.


Tasmanian tigers are also known as thylacines after their Latin name, Thylacinus cynocephalus. In 1936, the last captive Tasmanian tiger died in the Hobart 200.

Tasmanian tigers hunted wombats, wallabies, kangaroos, birds and other small mammals.

The Tasmanian tiger was about 1.5 m long and had light brown fur with dark stripes across its lower back.
