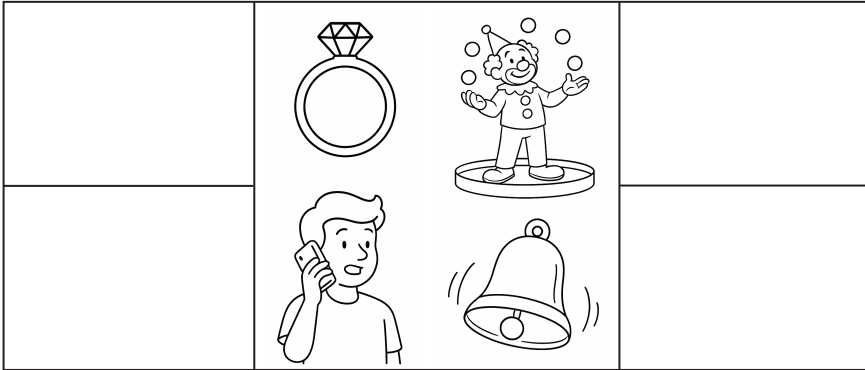


# Homographs

Homographs are words with the same spelling that have different meanings. Sometimes they are pronounced differently.

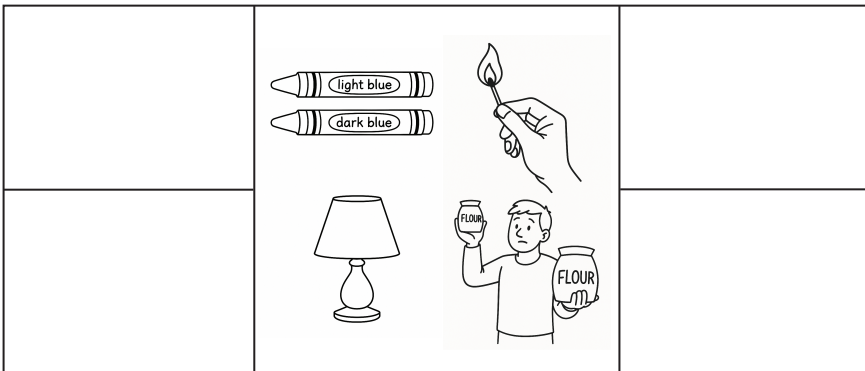
