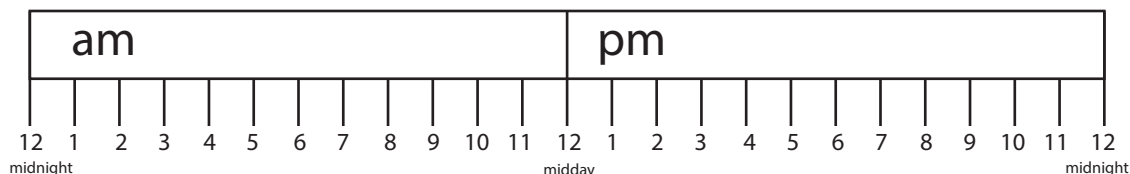
### What time is it?

People often write the letters am or pm after the time. This is because we use a 12 hour clock and there are 24 hours in a day. There are two times of the day when it is 12 o'clock, for example. To prevent confusion, we add am and pm so we know which time we are referring to. The letters are abbreviations for the latin words 'ante meridien' and 'post meridien'.

I'm expected at the hour of 1V ... is that ante meridien or post meridien?



- The latin words ante (before) and meridien (noon) mean **before noon**. We use **am** for times before noon.
- The latin words post (after) and meridien (noon) mean **after noon**. We use **pm** for times after noon.

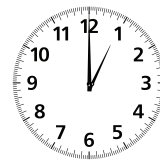

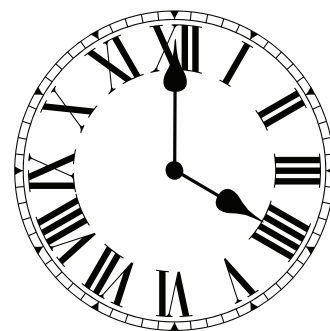
