There are over 2,000 varieties of cheeses.

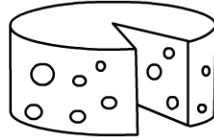
Swiss cheese has holes in it.

Cheese and pizzas

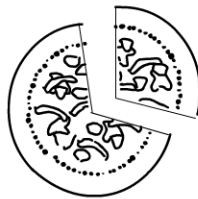
The first pizzas had no cheese. They were just dough and tomato sauce.
