Suffix 'est'

The suffix 'est' can be added to some adjectives and adverbs to show their superlative forms. Superlatives are used to show the greatest degree when comparing three or more objects or the actions three or more subjects in a group.

... For one syllable words ...

add 'est' to the adverb or adjective to form the superlative

... For words some words with 2 or more syllables ...

add 'most' or 'least' to the word to form the superlative form

... For adverbs ending in 'ly' ...

add 'most' or 'least' to the adverb to form the superlative



Remember, the usual suffix spelling rules still apply:

- * Doubling final consonants after a short vowel
- * Change 'y' to 'i' when adding a suffix beginning with a vowel
- * For one syllable words ending in silent 'e', drop the final 'e' when adding a suffix
