

Measure these world record distances on a wall in the playground. Imagine being able to jump that high!


Have a jumping competition with your class:

<u>Men:</u> Javier Sotomayor (Cuba) 27 July 1993 (Salamanca, Spain) 2.45 m (8ft 2.5 in)

<u>Women:</u> Stefka Kostadinova (Bulgaria) 30 August 1987 (Rome, Italy) 2.09 m (6 ft 10.28 in)
