
The Digestive System

Stage 1: Biting




Stage 5: Stomach

Stage 3: Swallowing




Stage 7: Large Intestine

Stage 8: Waste Removal



Food is swallowed pushing it into the oesophagus.

Nutrients are absorbed into the bloodstream.

Food is chewed to break it down into smaller pieces.

A part of the food is bitten off into a manageable piece.

Water is absorbed from the indigestible food.

Waste passes out of the body.

Chemicals break the food down into a liquid.

Food travels down towards the stomach.
