

## Plurals -retaining Latin spelling



\* Changing a final "us" to "i" is an example of retaining Latin spelling when forming plurals.

example: cactus - us then + i to make the plural = cacti	
Make plurals from these words by removing the 'us' and adding 'i':	Δ
cactus fungus	
radius octopus	
* Sometimes "i" is changed to "e" to form a plural, retaining Latin spelling.  example: crisis change 'i' to 'e' to make the plural = crises  Make plurals from these words by changing the 'i' to 'e':	o! gain!
axis basis	
* Sometimes the final "ix" or "ex" is removed and "ices" is added, retaining Latin spelling.	$\sim$
example: $index$ + ices to make the plural = $indices$	43
