Action verbs are something that a person, animal, or object can do.

An action verb describes an action.

Andrew <u>carried</u> the two bags at the same time.

Jennifer watched the birds building a nest.

Roland catches the ball.

The girls ran across the field.

I kicked the ball toward the goal.



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Action verbs

Action verbs can also be mental actions such as: think, ponder, imagine, believe, and wonder.

Joanne thought about her homework.

Mary guessed the correct answer.

James pondered the answer.

I <u>remember</u> your first Christmas.
