

A noun is a word for a person, place or thing.

person: man, woman, doctor, Harry, Hillary

place: home, town, countryside, Australia

thing: chair, car, apple, money, dog, mouse



Nouns can be divided into two types: Common nouns and Proper nouns.

Common Nouns

A **common noun** is the name of any ordinary person, place or thing.

Examples: shoe, tree, cat, whistle, beach, pear, girl.

Proper Nouns

A proper noun is the actual name of a person, place or thing. Proper nouns start with capital letters.

Examples: Sunday, England, America, Tokyo, Sarah, Jonah, Sam, Eiffel Tower, Mount Everest.


