

Shades of meaning.

Shades of meaning refers to the slight differences in meaning between similar words or phrases.

For example:

Something can be described as **big**.

Words such as **large**, **huge**, **gigantic**, **enormous** and **massive** also relate to size, but show varying shades of meaning.

They are more specific in meaning.

That dog is **big**.

That dog is **huge**.

That dog is **massive**.



More examples:

Can you see how each word changes the strength of the meaning.

The flower is **nice**.

The flower is **beautiful**.

The flower is **gorgeous**.

The flower is **stunning**.

The comedian is **funny**.

The comedian is **witty**.

The comedian is **hilarious**.
