



Adding to 10 with visual cues - problems

- 1 Aisha ate 3 apples and Henry ate 4 apples. How many apples did they eat altogether?





- 3 There are 4 cars on the upper level and 5 cars on the lower level. How many cars altogether?





- 5 There are two groups of birds flying together. Five in one group and three in the other. How many birds are flying together?





- 7 On my desk there are two pencil tins. One with five pencils the other with five pencils. How many pencils on my desk?





- 2 Mal caught 4 fish in the morning and 5 fish in the afternoon. How many fish did he catch during the day?




