
Comparing Length



Draw a picture of the tallest person in your family.



Find 5 things that are different lengths. Place them in order from shortest to longest.

Find 5 things that are different heights. Place them in order from shortest to tallest.

Find an object that can be used to compare length. For example, a pencil, a ruler, a broom etc. Find things around the home that are longer and shorter than the object. For example: The table is longer than the broom. The shelf is shorter than the broom.

Compare the child's height to things around the home. For example, "The door is taller than me." "I am taller than the desk." Or the child can even say, "The desk is shorter than me."
