

Adding decimals

The most important thing when adding (or subtracting) decimals is in the 'setting out'.

Line up the decimal points then add like any other sum.

$$34.02 + 6.73 + 0.003 =$$

WHEN SETTING OUT THE EQUATION THE DECIMAL POINTS NEED TO LINE UP.

$$\begin{array}{r} 34.020 \\ 6.730 \\ + 0.003 \\ \hline 40.753 \end{array}$$

↪ line up the point

Calculate the answer to each decimal addition.

$$23.003 + 3.384 + 0.94 =$$

$$\begin{array}{r} 23.003 \\ 3.384 \\ + 0.940 \\ \hline \hline \end{array}$$

$$101.21 + 4.44 + 22.54 =$$
