



# Multiplying two digit numbers by a one digit number

- 1 Each truck is carrying 23 t of coal. What is the combined weight of coal on all 4 trucks?







- 5 74 oranges are cut into quarters. How many quarters are there?





- 7 A length of pipe is cut into three 57 cm long pieces. What was the length of the pipe before it was cut?





- 2 6 classes each with 32 students went on an excursion to the rainforest. How many students went on the excursion?





- 4 Each box contains 84 butter knives. Bree bought 5 boxes of butter knives for her restaurant. How many knives did she buy?




