Past Tense Verbs

Past tense verbs describe an action that has happened in the past.

Many past tense verbs are formed by adding "ed", to the verb.

play - played



Study*ladder*



Yesterday, the children <u>played</u> in the park.

Past Tense Verbs

Past tense verbs formed by adding "ed" to the verb are called regular verbs.

Examples of regular verbs:



Past Tense Irregular Verbs

The past tense of some verbs do not end in "ed". These are called irregular verbs.

Examples of irregular verbs:

bite - bit

draw - drew

drink - drank

make - made grow - grew

ride - rode sing - sang



ring - rang

fight - fought teach - taught

wake - woke swim - swam

fly - flew
